Overview

eNovation 9 focuses on retaining the sense of 'key' as the hand extends towards an octave and when employing wider position shifts on the keyboard. Students learn the feel of the various intervals within the 7th and to cross the 3rd finger to complete the one octave scale. Visualization of the major and minor scales on the keyboard is stressed so that reading skills develop properly, limiting the need for students to look at their hands when moving on the keys. The root position V7 chord and its resolution is a special focus found throughout this eNovation. Beginning in this eNovation hymn/chorales will be included in the score reading area.
