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Topic 1: One Octave Scales (White Key) / Extending to the 7th / Asymmetrical Meters

Lesson Goals			
In this lesson, students acquire basic techniques to extend to the 7th, both melodically and harmonically. Students should achieve topographical security in a variety of keys as they begin to travel greater distances on the keyboard. Crossing the 3rd finger to complete the one octave scale is taught here. Asymmetrical Meters is presented in the Rhythm Drill with a direct application of it in the repertoire, <i>Kaleidoscope</i> .
